## Beers of The Week

### Draught:

#### **Orbit *Tzatziki Sour* – Berliner Weisse 4.3%**

“Straw yellow colour, hazy, white foamy head with aromas of cucumber, mint, yoghurt and lemon & lime citrus with light malt character. Creamy smooth mouthfeel but mildly tart lactic sourness. Light & dry finish with mellow bitterness and soft to medium carbonation.”

#### **Gravity Well *Omicron Persei 9* – Pale Ale 5.0%**

“Omicron Persei 9 is the latest pale ale from Gravity Well. Soft, creamy and full of Citra and Simcoe, this one is dangerously drinkable. Get it while you can!”

#### **Kernel *London 1856* – Imperial Brown Stout 9.5%**

“Round and smooth. Gentle. Coffee and cocoa aroma, then leading to dark fruits, dried fruits, raisin, fig, prune. Even plum. Some sour berries. Through the long finish of hop bitterness entwined with roast and char.”

### Bottle Shop:

#### **Europe – Brouwerij Verhaeghe *Duchesse De Bourgogne* 6.2%**

“The traditional Flemish red ale. This refreshing ale is matured in oak casks; smooth with a rich texture and interplay of passion fruit, and chocolate, and a long, dry and acidic finish.”

#### **UK – Orbit *Hefeweizen* 5.5%**

“A Bavarian favourite characterised by its soft texture, subtle fruity banana and spicy clove yeast esters, and light citric tartness.”

#### **Villages *Rodeo Pale Ale* 4.6%**

“Light straw colour with a gentle haze. Citrus and grapefruit aromas and flavours come from Citra and Cascade, giving a balanced floral tone. Low bitterness and a soft body.”

#### **UnBarred *Stoutzilla '20 Imperial Stout* 10.0%**

“Brewed with cold steeped coffee from the lovely people over at Pharmacie Coffee Roasters as well as decadent cocoa nibs, Madagascan vanilla and bourbon whiskey for a luxurious depth of flavour.”

#### **US – The Tank Brewing Co. *La Playita Hop-Accented Pils* 5.1%**

“Old and New worlds collide in this hop-accented pils, where German brewing tradition meets modern American craft innovation. Cold lager fermentation coupled with one of the palest and finest malts available creates a crisp and flavorful palate with a clean finish.”
