## Beers of The Week

### Draught:

#### **Siren *Lumina* – Session IPA 4.2%**

“Glowing with juicy tropical fruit notes. Hoppy aromas of mango and pineapple guide you towards explosive flavour, flashes of delicate citrus highlights and refreshing balanced bitterness.”

#### **Orbit *Dead Wax* – London Porter 5.5%**

“*Dead Wax* is Orbit’s take on a classic London Porter. Based on the late nineteenth-century interpretation of the style. Complex rich malt, with aromas of chocolate, coffee, caramel and malty biscuit. More chocolate, coffee and black treacle on the palate.”

#### **Pastore *Limone* – Fruited Sour 2.5%**

“A low-alcohol mixed-culture sour beer conditioned on Sicilian lemons and a small amount of mandarin oranges and pink grapefruit.”

### Bottle Shop:

#### **Europe – Westmalle Trappist *Tripel* 9.5%**

“This Triple lures you in with its sweet banana aromas, but then provides a hoppy bitterness as a background to the aroma symphony. Its malty body is enriched with yeasty alcohol esters and hop flowers. The character is predominantly herbal and earthy but it is enlivened by CO2 pearls, ensuring a lively character overall.”

#### **UK – Orbit Hefeweizen 5.5%**

“A Bavarian favourite characterised by its soft texture, subtle fruity banana and spicy clove yeast esters, and light citric tartness.”

#### **Duration *Turtles All the Way Down* American Pale Ale 5.5%**

“Pronounced hops and a rounded body with soft bitterness. “If the beer world is balanced on the back of a giant hop, what supports that hop?” “Why it’s hops all the way down, of course.”.”

#### **Anspach & Hobday *The Imperial Baltic Porter* 9.0%**

“Aromas of chocolate and roasted coffee dominate the nose, along with notes of herbs & spice. The palate is smooth and chocolatey, with a touch of sweetness balanced by a gentle bitterness.”

#### **US – The Tank Brewing Co. *La Playita* Hop-Accented Pils 5.1%**

“Old and New worlds collide in this hop-accented pils, where German brewing tradition meets modern American craft innovation. Cold lager fermentation coupled with one of the palest and finest malts available creates a crisp and flavorful palate with a clean finish.”
